Aristide Brissard – patriarch – Madame Brissard

Maurice – oldest son, wife Marie-Therese – onboard affair Germaine de Margeville, then Marguerite Varans – her daughters also affaired with Maurice on crossing – wife Marie-Therese sexually intimate with Adrienne Dumoutier – Maurice assumed so after seeing Monique Chabrol painting – Adrienne, after a long tease, began an affair with Maurice – but he thought the victory was his Plaisir 247

Michel – second son, married to Nicole – Marguis de Sade to Ninette Laval – met Ginette Royer on Metro – and Ginette's sales assistant Gaby

Wife Nicole, with encouragement from Jeanne, begin seeing Pierre de Barbin who drives a gleaming maroon Panhard-Levassor open tourer, they do it in car, on street, under table at cafe

Charles – third son – married with a child – Slept with Madame Cottard – Slept with Jaqueline Le Pretre met on business travel – has a child – slept with cousin Teresa – slept with cousin by marriage, Marie-Veronique -

Jeanne – daughter – husband Guy Verney – Armand Budin, first lover after marriage (2 yr affair), ended with Jeanne pregnant, she claimed by her husband, remained friends - affair, Christophe Larousse, told him he was father – Husband Guy Verney – rich – masochist (see Yvette Begard) – Dr. Moulin reported his masochism traumas to Maurice who told Jeanne, over

time with Jeanne, and attorney Bernard Gaillard they intervened placing Guy in the care of Mme Ernestine Noiret who helped him get it up (and in) without S&M abuse – Jeanne had a tryst with Bernard (well-endowed) – friend of Monique Chabol, Jeanne's sister was married to Alexandre St Amand Monte-Royal who was Monique's brother and killed in the war (Folies 79)

Octavie – daughter

Gerard – youngest son - friend Christophe, picked up Sophie, she added neighbor Adele (manage a trois)

~Christophe Larousse – his father, cousin of Guy Verney, killed Verdun - Christophe – only child – told by mother, Madame Larousse to embrace uncle (Verney) - Works for Verney, one of five clerks – supervised by Henri Dufour – had affair with Jeanne - moved into apartment in building where M Robineau, who has dealings with Guy, lives with his wife and daughter, Danielle, 19. Christophe has maid, Miele, who also serves between lovers – Robineaus consider him a candidate for marriage to Danielle who is a virgin and intends to remain so until a marriage is arranged – heavy petting okay, but no penetration - though he comes, he visits Maison Suzy where he likes Gaby - as a girl, she liked (kissed, turned on by) her uncle, Armand Budin, who had an affair with Jeanne – Danielle introduced him to her friend Claire Diard, had affair, Danielle caught them - affair with Jeanne (Guy Verney's wife) resulted in pregnancy which ended the affair and later his job when business sold – Went to Cannes, where he was invited to the villa of the Vicomtesse de la Vergne (Regine – 50, rich, plain, and sagging) (the Vicomte has left her and lives abroad) on the recommendation to Regine by Jeanne – he diddles a little with Regine but runs off with Nicolette (born Isobel but Regine changed name), Regine's sisters daughter, she is darker, her father a Spanish nobleman, parents went down with the Lusitania, Nicolette is an heiress in her own right

~Germaine de Margeville – wife of Georges, coffee broker – danced with Maurice, during a crossing – her stocking foot to his privates under table at dinner while he talked to Georges – Antoinette – their blind daughter – love tricked Maurice - Michele – other daughter – bait to get Maurice with Antoinette – he also fooled with Michele – Germaine introduced Maurice to

Marguerite Varans, affair – Major Paul Jonquy introduced her to fitness – Olaf, masseur Tues and Wed mornings – Gaston Doucet, fencing, Mon & Fri – other men – Dr. Massanet, 2x month – Roger, boutique manager, regular calls – Father David, then Father Pierre, weekly confession

~Mademoiselle Angelique – Plaisir 18 – Madagascar mulatto prostitute

~Madame Lombard – Plaisir 60

~Madame Cottard – Plaisir 60 – Charles fooling with

~Saint-Rochat – friend/colleague Aristide

Eugenie – daughter – Gerard described as unresponsive

~Gabrielle de Michoux – War widow - Jeanne Verney introduced Armand Budin to her – has her maid, Claudine, pre-screen lovers, like Armand – touch of old-fashioned values(smile)debates the moral question -

~Armand Budin – unmarried - friend/lover Jeanne Verney – affair with Dominique DeLavel – affair with Madeleine Beauvais – Madame Cottier, widow, Armand's discreet, enabling, domestic -

~Henri Chenet – rich friend of Gabrielle – possible husband – interviewed by Claudine, and rejected, awkward (and maybe to please Armand)

~Adrienne Dumoutier – sexually intimate friend of Marie-Therese

Catholic school friends Plaisir 93 – got involved with Maurice after a long tease to

~Jaqueline Le Pretre – “Not shaven. Plucked hair.” Oriental style (Plaisir 129,130) – f,Charles when running away from Husband to be with Mehmet, Turkish Prince – 30 orgasms a session, likes 2 one hour sessions a day – Mehmet also likes young boys and other women

~Monique Chabrol – friend of Jeanne Verney - related by marriage to Madame Brissard – stimulates young male and female models (Alain and his girlfriend Suzanne) near orgasm by talking as she paints, then a flicks them off – copied (Plaisir146) master painting but added faces of Madame Brissard and Madame Dumoutier – has orgasms when painting her own jou-jou – has half a dozen friends who, at her invitation, come over for sex

– relieves self when models leave – brought Gerard into a *Dejeuner sur l'Herbe* tryst with Monsieur Creux, model Mademoiselle Marchand and Monique – another time she fondled young model Denise like a guitar in view of Gerard – Jeanne Verney's sister was married to Alexandre St Amand Monte-Royal who was Monique's brother and killed in the war (Folies 79) – Monique's younger brother Giles St Amand Mont-Royal was selected by Marie-Claire Feneon, Giles had previous affair with Vicomtesse de la Vergne and later Gabrielle de Michoux (whose maid screened her lovers)

~Yvette Begard – as punishment for poor/brief performance (shortcoming), introduced, by force, Guy Verney to masochism with her friend, Solange, using a pin laden device they call “Minette” Plaisir 173 – he asked for more

~Madame Joligny – Christophe's concierge, widow, some intimacy between her large breasts visits M'sieu Lafon at the bakery -daughter, Bernadette, 12, provides care for Christophe during his tonsillitis – playful wrestling to orgasm (went off pop) but no penetration. Joligny blackmailed him (cause of foolin' with Bernadette) into accepting Merielle (has widowed mother, her late husband's sister), her niece, 18 but no virgin, as a maidservant (at twice the price), with benefits.

~Dr. Fasquelle – treats Christophe's tonsillitis, sent by Jeanne Verney

~Nanette Laval – Parents died 1912, Titanic, fiancé died early in the war – S&M with Michel – got pregnant after 3 months

~Madame Floquet – patron of the arts, music

----moving to Joie d'Amour

~Ginette Royer – young, father killed in war, sales assistant – met Michel on Metro – began affair – she used term “synchronized” love making - Michel became an investor in her fashion boutique – along with (later learned) Armand Budin, Monsieur Falaise, with whom she was also intimate – has new fiancé also – her sales assistant, Gaby, also took up with Ginette

~Bernard Gaillard – 30, unmarried, proud and well-endowed, reputation – only goes with married women – Madame Vosges - Madame Toussaint – Madame Benet - Met Simone Lebrun at party at Maurice and Marie-Therese home – visited with friend, Dr. Jean-Albert Faguet to consult about Simone screwing but not participating with her own orgasm – Faguet took Bernard Lulu

~Simone Lebrun – husband Leon and 6 yr old son Leon - affair with to Moulin Rouge and hooked up with Mademoiselle Gaby and her friend

Bernard Gaillard – husband, Leon, in business venture with Maurice – tried out Bernard at party – doesn't orgasm with him, but good – In appointment screw up, Leon found Bernard erect expecting Simone

~Teresa di Monferrato - her mother, Marie, is a sister of Aristide Brissard? - so Teresa is cousin of Brissard kids - married a wealthy, older, Italian Marchese, Rinaldo, Marchese di Monferrato. Slept with all of the Brissard sons, in turn, and became pregnant – Rinaldo was delighted at last to have a son

~Jean-Albert Faguet – doctor specializing in intimate problems with celebrity woman – often exams include sex – Mademoiselle Renee Lalouche – Madame Marie-Paule Boyer – Mlle Blanche Pasigny – Mlle Josette Leduc – Mlle Christiane Cartier – Mlle Nadine Vallette – Charlotte Pascal –

~Marcel Chalon – slept with Yvonne Daladier – after she no-showed, Yvonne's maid, Cecile, tended to him with Yvonne's underwear after Yvonne broke off the affair – affair with Gabrielle de Michoux – affair with Sylvie Tournt

~Yvonne Daladier – looking for a husband - affair with Marcel Chalon – then off with M Aubernon who went bankrupt – tried to get back with Marcel, he no-showed – affair with Paul-Henri Courval, who he sent to her Fortune Teller, Mademoiselle Marie (with whom she also trysts)

~Pauline Devreux – affair with Larnac – daughter Gisele, 18 – caught Gisele and her school friend, Roger – ended up messing with Roger (father a senator), cousin to Gerard, and agreed that he would be shared with her and her daughter

~Marcel Chalon – 30, lives with his Mother and her two servants, Annette 30 the younger – affair Madame Georgette Bataille, wife of a friend of his – at ballet, sat near Marie-Madeleine 20 who never disclosed her identity, had Arabian Nights affair "disappoint me once and you will never see me again" "astonish me", champagne bath (8 to 10 dozen bottles), Metro, under trees Bois de Boulogne, under colonnades Palais Royal, Parapet Pont des Arts, doorways, arches, secret corners, she ended affair to marry fiance when she got pregnant – meanwhile to going to Annette's room when frustrated and she got pregnant, and put up in a house out of Paris -

~Georges Bonfils – a joker, elaborate farces, nude bicycle event with greased seats – Cirque Erotique, riders: Marie, Jeanne, Marianne, Sophie (winner – 7 wave orgasms) – Guests: Raymond Provost (bet on winner and went home with her), Xavier de Margeville

~Celestine Duperray – gossip many young men, but names never revealed - rich husband, Raoul Duperray, kind of gangster type (trysts with two young girls), friend of Charles Brissard – Celestine selected journalist Nicolas Bruneau, met at Opera Ball, had affair, she likes it in rear, Raoul had him brought in the make deal, Nicolas would continue affair with Celestine, but work for Raoul

~Marie-Claire Feneon – heiress – narcissist, crystal room - rare beauty, painted by Monique Chalon, full length nude – she invites Monique's younger brother Giles St Amand Mont-Royal (see Monique above) into the Crystal Room (first such invitation – usually enjoys it alone)

~Andre Geroud – uncle is Aristide Brissard, cousin Maurice - served, shrapnel in right leg - business acquaintance Adolphe Lacoste, acquainted with M Moncourbier whose household run by Mme Cabuchon whose daughter Lucette was "little angel" to Moncourbier – Lucette grew up and became involved with a crazy Russian Prince who shot himself accidentally, then worked with Lacoste in scams that eventually included Jaques Malplaquet and an affair with Andre which backfired on Lucette and Lacoste because Maurice fed Andre flawed business info to entrap the pair, Lucette was like a member of Catherine de Medici "flying squad" (slept around and brought back intelligence).

~ Paul-Henri Courval – Yvonne Daladier sends him to her Fortune Teller, Mme Marie to size him up as possible husband –

~Marcelle Delaroque – travels, speaks, writes articles feminist issues, 3rd wife of older, jealous, member of League of Nations - affair with single Jean-Claude Sorbier - Laurence Callot, close friend of Jean-Claude, having affair with Marie-Veronique Blois (cousin of another friend, Charles Brissard), whose husband is having an affair with a Polish opera singer – Laurence has a menage-a-trois with Mme's Brigitte Bergerac and Marianne Clavel in Bordeaux while following Marcelle – with whom he eventually connect

~Madeleine Beauvais – 29, sensual, husband Pierre-Louis, married 8 years, H having affair, she has reputation of unattainable, many tried, rejected – Claude Bonheur, attorney, disgraced himself – Affair with Armand Budin while separated and living with her sister Yvonne Hiver – got pregnant by Armand and went back to her husband who had broken up with Suzette

~Dominique Delaval – formerly married, too constricting – affair with Armand Budin (when he started affair with Madeleine)

~Vincent Moreau – lycee friend Armand Budin – wife Brigitte – fondled Dominique's bottom dancing at Les Acacias

Pierre-Louis Beauvais – H of Madeleine – cousin of Armand – affair with young Suzette, got rough (he suspected she had another lover –

Yvonne Hiver – sister of Madeleine – married to Jean-Roger who visits the apartment infrequently – seduced Armand

Suzette Chenet – 19 – living with, and sexual relationship with, Fernande Quibon,- affair with Pierre-Louis Beauvais – affair with Armand – menage a trois, Armand and Fernande

Fernande Quibon – H died in Verdun – services older Marc Leblanc – sleeps with guest, Suzette Chenet – seduced Armand but no coitus - three-some, Suzette and Armand

Madame Valerie Chalon – formerly Mademoiselle Lombard - widow of Jean-Jaques Chalon (assumed Marcel was his son) – mother of Marcel Chalon – past lover of Adolphe Lacoste who went to Madagascar (leaving her pregnant, so she married) -

Gabrielle de Michoux – young widow, husband died on western front - engaged to older Adolph Lacoste, who had affair with Marcel's mother, Madame Chalon, apparently Marcel's real father - affair with Marcel Chalon in Cannes – Claudine is her domestic, serviced Marcel when Adolphe unexpectedly took Gabrielle out -

Adolph Lacoste – engaged to Gabrielle de Michoux - had affair with Marcel's mother, Madame Chalon, apparently Marcel's real father – half-sister, Sylvie Tournet, separated from her husband, lives with Adolphe –

Sylvie Tournet – separated from husband Gaston Tournet, a monster – living with half-brother Adolph Lacoste – affair with Claude Belanger – affair with Marcel – dressed as man and with Marcel trysted with Marie and Nanette at a brothel – planning marriage to Claude – slips off on Orient Express with Marcel

Danielle Robineau – 19? – Madame Chalon would like Marcel to marry her – fools around with Marcel above the waist, until after Pierre Martin– Marcel took her virginity but withdrew – her mother tried to force Marcel to marry Danielle, he refused – Danielle became Pierre Martin's lover -

Pierre Martin – lawyer friend of Marcel – tried to seduce Danielle Robineau who, when Marcel avoided marriage, became Pierre's lover
